Itinerary

[Day 1] Singapore — Milan - - Meal on Board

Assemble at Changi International Airport and begin your vacation with a pleasant flight towards **Milan**, a city in Northern Italy.

[Day 2] Milan — Mestre - L -

Welcome to Milan, a global capital of fashion and design. Stroll through the compound of the **Sforza Castle** and be impressed by Leonardo da Vinci's design. Adore the world's largest Gothic Cathedral, the **Milan Duomo** and the **Opera House** and **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II**, the oldest active shopping mall with a stunning interior covered with glass and iron roof. [Day 3] Mestre — Venice — Tuscany B L (Seafood) -

We will visit the Venetian Glass Factory and admire the technique of crafting Murano Glass and see the marvellous technique of how this ancient glass was made. [Day 4] Tuscany — Florence — Tuscany B - D (Florentine Steak)

Let us make our way to Florence, starting off with **Piazzale Michelangelo**, a square with fantastic panoramic view of Florence. This is followed by viewing the Duomo where we can see the Cathedral of **Santa Maria Del Fiore**, Door of Paradise. Then, continue to the **Ponte Vecchio**, the oldest bridge over **Arno River** and **Piazza Della Signoria** the view of immense political and artistic presence of the Renaissance city.

[Day 5] Tuscany — Pisa — The Mall — Rome B - -

Let us move on to the iconic **Leaning Tower of Pisa**, a famous free-standing bell tower structure at **Campo dei Miracoli**, the **Baptistry of St John** and the **Duomo**. [Day 7] Rome — Amalfi Coast — Naples

Next, Amalfi, the absolute must-visit sight of **Duomo**, the towering cathedral which dominates the main piazza of the town.

Wrap up the day with **Naples**, an orientation sightseeing to the heart of the city **Castel Nuovo** and its **Triumphal Arch**, the **San Carlo Theatre**, the **Royal Palace of Naples**, **Galleria Umberto** – the public shopping gallery, **Piazza del Plebistico** – a large central square.
