

Where is Phu Quoc?

Phu Quoc of the Southwest is an island separated from the mainland and also the largest island in Vietnam with an area of up to 574 square kilometers. The island also belongs to the Gulf of Thailand. Phu Quoc Island is located quite close to Cambodia which is just 14 nautical miles from the coast of Kampot province.

From Vietnam, the island is 65 nautical miles (about 120 kilometers) from Rach Gia town and 25 nautical miles (about 45 kilometers) from Ha Tien town.

There are two large towns of An Thoi and Duong Dong and eight communes in the island.



Phu Quoc island district consists of 36 islands from a large and small island, of which Phu Quoc island is the largest.

How to Get to Phu Quoc



People usually travel to Phu Quoc via four popular transportation methods: airplane, sleeper bus, motorbike, or hydrofoil. By airplane

The fastest way to go to Phu Quoc is fly to the Dwong Đông airport (PQC) from Hanoi, Saigon, or Can Tho.

There are three airlines that operate a direct flight from these cities to Phu Quoc. You can choose to fly with <u>Vietnam Airlines, Vietjet Air,</u> or <u>Jetstar Pacific.</u>

Depending on your departure location, date, and the airline, a one-way ticket will cost upwards of 700,000 VND (35 USD).










Why you should visit Phu Quoc



Best time to visit Phu Quoc

Phu Quoc has a tropical climate. There are only really two seasons are:

The dry season: from October and continues through March. (High season)

The weather in Phu Quoc is basically hot and humid all year round,

April and May, which are the hottest months of the year.

The monsoons between July to September (Low Season)

It is necessary to bring a hat, sunglasses and summer clothing when travel to Phu Quoc.

Day 03 Phu Quoc island boat tour

Breakfast at hotel.

5:00am Pick up from your hotel and transfer to An Thoi Harbor, boarding the boat for sunrise fishing tour. Enjoy Vietnamese coffee & sunrise morning on the sea.
